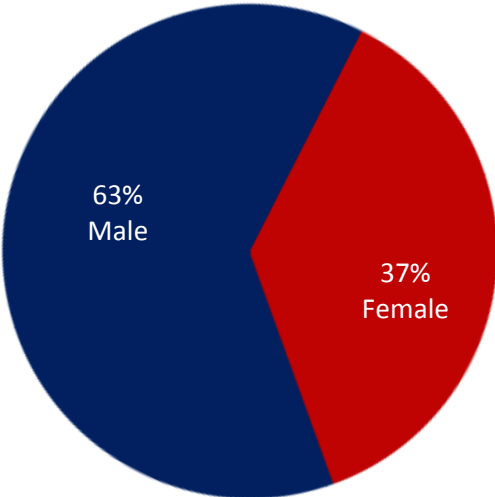

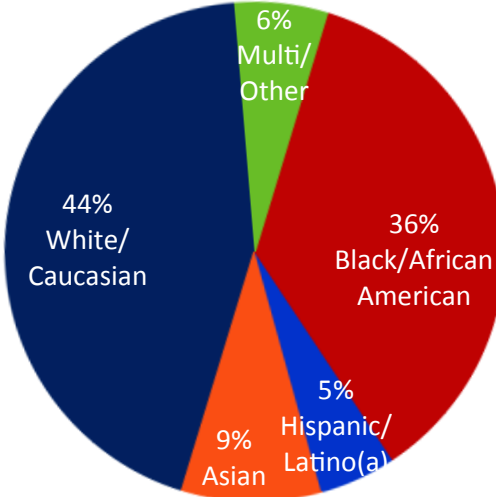

Demographics

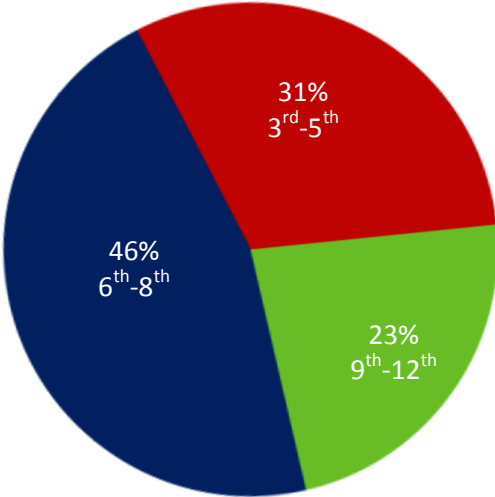
Students by Gender
