Carla also serves as the Secretary for the Columbus STEM Industry Council (SInC) and is a member of the National Center for Women and Information Technology (NCWIT) K-12 Alliance, the Computer Science Teachers Association (CSTA) Ohio Chapter and the National Alliance for Partnerships in Equity (NAPE). In 2017, Carla was featured in "Columbus Women Leading, Innovating, Engaging in Technology" by Columbus Underground.
